ITINERARY

NOTE: The places visited may vary by day or be replaced for weather reasons.

DAY 1 - Friday - TÓRSHAVN, THE CAPITAL

Upon arrival to the airport a taxi driver welcomes the traveler/s with a sign with the "Faroe Tours" logo or with your name.

Transfer to Hotel Brandan****, located in the capital, Tórshavn. On this 40-minute journey you cross the first subsea tunnel in the Faroe Islands, with the deepest point at 105 meters below sea level.

Rest of the day on your own in Tórshavn. We recommend you take a walk downtown.

DAY 2 - Saturday - MYKINES ISLAND

Transfer to Sørvágur to take the ferry to Mykines Island. Here we'll walk approx. 2 hours passing through the famous puffin colony. This is undoubtedly a spectacular place to spot these and many other birds.

On this hike you also explore other areas of the island, from spectacular purely Atlantic cliffs to the narrow streets of the cozy village, unique on the island.

After a few unforgettable hours in Mykines, you will return by ferry to Sørvágur and from here to the hotel in Tórshavn.

DAY 3 - Sunday - STREYMOY ISLAND

Departing from the fishing port of Vestmanna you will sail on a 2-hour boat trip to the high cliffs of Vestmannabjörgini.

You navigate through narrow passes and caves, next to 600 meter high cliffs where birds such as puffins, guillemots, fulmars and kittiwakes nest every summer.

The route today continues to the Fossá waterfall (140m), the highest in the Faroe Islands.

Finally we visit the village of Saksun, surrounded by high mountains and a lake that leads to the Atlantic. Return to Tórshavn.

DAY 4 - Monday - KALSOY ISLAND

We start the day heading to Borðoy, gateway to the northern islands, islands with small fishing villages dominated by high mountains.

In Klaksvík we take the ferry to Kalsoy Island.

Upon arrival, we cross several tunnels to the town of Mikladalur, where we visit the famous statue of Kópakonan (the seal woman). Here we will learn about the legend that accompanies it.



ITINERARY

We continue further north, to the village of Trøllanes, from where we take a hiking route to the famous Kallur lighthouse, one of the most photographed points of the Faroe Islands. Finally, ferry back to Klasvík and route to Tórshavn.

DAY 5 - Tuesday - VÁGAR ISLAND

Our guide picks up the group at the hotel reception at 9:00 a.m.

The day begins with a panoramic tour of the Sørvágsfjørð fjord with views of Tindhólmur islet and Mykines Island. You will visit the picturesque villages of Bøur and Gásadalur.

Here you visit Mulafoossur, the famous waterfall that falls into the sea.

Until recently the only way to get to Gásadalur was on foot across the mountains, although now a tunnel connects both villages.

Even so, Gásadalur still retains its authenticity and charm.

Afterwards, you'll go on a hike of approx. 2.30 hours in total to the Trælanípa cliffs, where you can see the famous point where an optical effect is produced with Lake Sørvágsvatn and the sea at 2 different levels.

Upon arrival in Tórshavn, the smallest capital in the world, our guide takes you on a walking tour around Tinganes, the oldest neighborhood in the city.

DAY 6 - Wednesday - EYSTUROY & BORÐOY ISLANDS

After crossing the Funningsfjørður, one of the most beautiful fjords of the archipelago, we hike to the top of Hvíthamar.

From here we contemplate the views over the fjord.

We continue to the village of Gjógv, one of the beautiful villages of the Faroe Islands.



ITINERARY

In the afternoon we drive up to Mount Klakkur, on the island of Borðoy. The views from the parking lot are already spectacular, but if you are in good shape you can hike with the guide to the highest part to contemplate the best views (approx. 1.30h total). Return to Tórshavn.

DAY 7 - Thursday - HESTUR AND KIRKJUBØUR

Day for an exciting activity. 10 minutes from the capital you take a semi-rigid boat to explore the surroundings of Hestur Island, visiting caves and cliffs. This tour lasts 1.5 hours.

Not far from here we visit Kirkjubøur, an important historical and cultural place where we visit Roykstovan, the oldest wooden house, 900 years old, the oldest Church in the Faroe Islands, from the year 1111, and the ruins of the cathedral of Saint Magnus, built around 1300.

Return to Tórshavn approx. at 1 p.m.

Free afternoon in Tórshavn to wander the streets on your own or relax in a portside cafe contemplating the life of the locals.

DAY 8 - Friday - DEPARTURE

Departure from the hotel reception. A taxi will pick you up 2h prior to your flight departure time. For example, if your flight is at 10.00am the taxi will pick you up at 08.00am.

The journey to the airport is 40 minutes.

NOTE: Taxi transfers from Tórshavn to the airport are always departing from Tórshavn 2 hours before the flight departure time. Given the characteristics of the airport, it is more than enough time to have 1.20 hours for check-in and boarding procedures.





THE HOTEL

The Faroe Islands are an environment of relaxing and welcoming environments. We want you to enjoy this aspect during your stay, so we have selected a hotel where you can enjoy maximum relaxation after a day of excursion and have the best of dreams during the night.

You will stay at the Brandan**** Hotel for the 7 nights of the trip. Located in Tórshavn, the capital, it is a modern 4-star hotel opened in 2020.

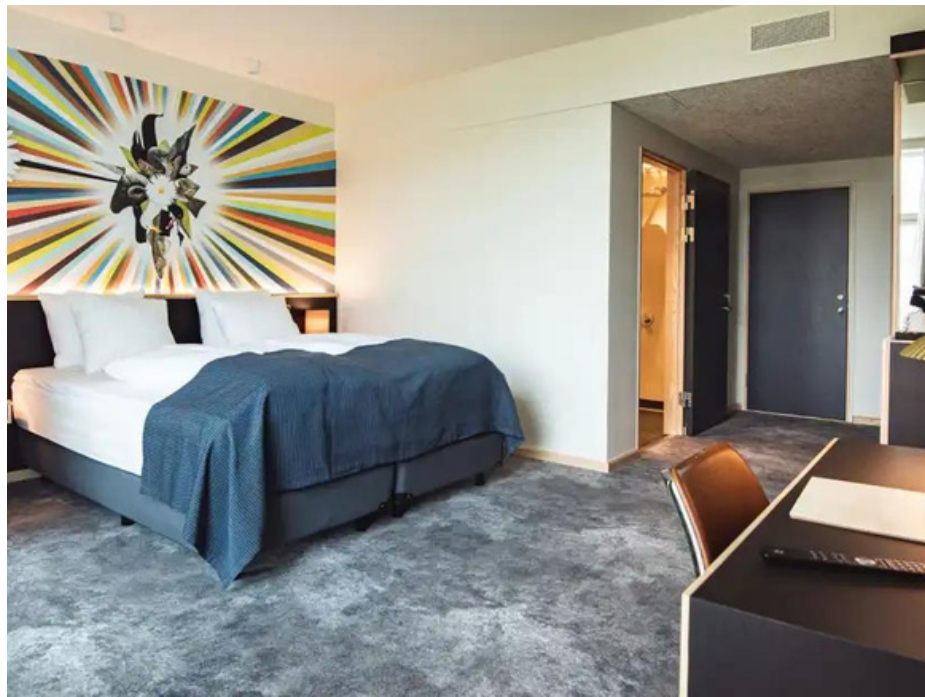
This hotel is located just a few minutes walk from the old town (Tinganes) and is close to all the bars and restaurants.

All rooms have a private bathroom and breakfast is buffet style.

The advantages of staying in Tórshavn...

The opening of a new subsea tunnel in 2020 makes it easier to visit all the points of interest without traveling long distances from the capital, which is in a central point of the archipelago, and provides many more dining options.

You will also avoid unpacking your suitcase every day.





MEALS

Eating on this trip

- Meals are not included in the price of the trip, since at lunch time the place where we stop to eat is variable (depending on the weather, pace of travel, etc.) and at night it is better for the traveler to have the flexibility to choose according to their needs, preferences and budget.
- Our guide will always stop to eat at lunch time in places with a varied menu within the possibilities of the country.
- For all these reasons, there is NO option to add half board on this trip.

Dining in Tórshavn

- The hotel is located 10 minutes walk from the city center, right where the vast majority of bars and restaurants are located and therefore the offer is very wide and diverse.
- In the best restaurants it is essential to reserve in advance. It is possible to reserve online.

Cost of meals in the Faroe Islands

- Although it varies and depends on the location, the price per person for a lunch in the Faroe Islands ranges from 120 DKK to 240 DKK per person.
- Likewise, the price of a dinner per person ranges from 220 DKK to 680 DKK per person.
- These prices do not include drinks, but water is always free.

1 DEPARTURE DATES

On our website ([CLICK here](#)) you can see the departure dates and available places. This is a regular trip with specific departure dates on Thursdays. For private tailor-made departures on other days, contact us.

2 FLY TO THE FAROES

The flight is not included in the cost of this trip. There are direct flights from Copenhagen or Barcelona with Atlantic Airways, the national airline of the Faroe Islands. Check www.atlanticairways.com.

3 TRANSFERS

Upon arrival to the airport a taxi driver welcomes the traveler/s with a sign with the "Faroe Tours" logo or with your name.

4 ACCOMMODATION

You will stay in a centrally located hotel in Tórshavn, the capital. All hotels have private bathroom in the room and buffet breakfast.

5 VEHICLE

The trip is made in our comfortable car, with ample space for luggage, free WiFi and Faroese music so you can get to know the local sounds.

6 LOCAL GUIDE

Our local guide speak English, knows the Faroe Islands perfectly and are prepared to offer you a comfortable, fun and unforgettable trip.

7 CLOTHING

The average temperature in summer in the Faroe Islands is around 11-15 degrees, so we recommend waterproof outerwear (also waterproof pants), comfortable mountain shoes and windbreakers.

8 PACE OF TRAVEL

The pace of this trip is calm, without rushing, where you can fully enjoy the places and relax on long journeys and in cozy hotels after a day of exploration.

9 HIKING

The hiking routes on this trip are simple and take between 2-3 hours maximum with a gradient of approximately 150 meters. Good fitness is advised, but they are all round trips along the same route, so it is possible not to finish them.

10 BILLS

The only thing not included in this trip are your personal expenses, lunches and dinners. It is recommended to pay everything by card, it is not necessary to change currency.

RECOMMENDED CLOTHING

Socks, comfortable pants (not jeans) and a long-sleeved t-shirt (even short-sleeved)

First layer



Waterproof mountain shoes, waterproof pants and comfortable sweater

Second cover



Hat, gloves, swimsuit and waterproof jacket

Third layer



•This list is based on a layered clothing system following the recommendation of our guides for the coldest days of summer.

•On some summer days it is even possible to wear short sleeves, but it is always good to bring warm clothes.

•The hotel has a sauna and hot water outdoor jacuzzis (additional cost to be paid at the hotel). For this reason we recommend a swimsuit.

The weather is of course changeable and unpredictable, so **you should always start the day of excursion with the appropriate clothing.**
